Entry Form

Showcase your "Vintage" container design to CanWest delegates and competition judges. You provide the plants, CanWest will supply the containers.

Containers

There are **15 containers available** and they will be reserved on a first-come basis; a waitlist will be available in the event that some participants have to drop out.

We ask that you create your design in a plastic insert (CanWest supplies a Pro-Can #7 SQ; this black plastic pot has a hard, square lip/edge that will hold itself up once inserted into the plastic container). Your creation will be placed in a decorative container at Tradex. This year, we will be using black containers that stand 28" high.



New for 2019! While past entries have been floral extravaganzas, the size and weight of some have created difficulties when placing them in the decorative containers.

Your entry must be easily hand-movable by no more than 2 people and have a low centre of gravity to avoid tipping. Entries that do not comply with these specifications may be **eliminated from the competition.**

Plant Up Options

Your container can be completed prior to arriving at Tradex or completed on-site, but it can only **arrive at Tradex on Tuesday, September 24, between 9 am and 5 pm.** Report to the show office located in the foyer; please ensure your company name is on your container.

Judging

Judging will take place on **Wednesday, September 25.** Ribbon placement will occur around 4 p.m., with winners announced at the Tailgate Party starting at 5 p.m. Consideration will be given to overall aesthetics, including **Variety and Size of Plants, Visual Appeal, Health of Plants, Use of Color, and Neatness.**

Judging is "blind" and the names of entrants are not displayed until after judging is complete.

Entry Deadline: September 6, 2019 or until all containers have been reserved.
